- Professionally represent company while overseeing contractors on various small to medium size pipeline maintenance projects.
- May perform limited carpentry and painting work.
- Operates heavy equipment.
- Assist with launch and receive of inline inspection tools.
- Assist in a variety of mechanical, technical, electrical and welding tasks as required.
- Respond appropriately to emergency situations and assist other team members in conducting drills.
- Inspect fire and other safety equipment and systems to ensure that they are maintained and operational.
