Wolverine Pipe Line Company is a transportation service company, headquartered in Portage, Michigan and incorporated in 1952. We have over 80 employees in the three states we operate - Michigan, Indiana and Illinois. Wolverine operates 700+ miles of active steel pipeline in three states, connecting Chicago refineries to terminals in Michigan and Northwest Indiana and moving product west to east. We transport over 350,000 barrels or 14.7 million gallons of refined products a day. Wolverine also provides approximately 30% of Michigan's daily refined products supply. We deliver the products that fuel the nation.

Wolverine does not own the product we ship. We are strictly a transport vehicle for our customers, much like UPS or FedEx is for packages. The Federal Government regulates the tariffs Wolverine charges to transport products between origins and destinations.

Summary of duties and responsibilities:

Lead a team of Electro Mechanics in daily field pipeline operations and maintenance activities within a work area ensuring compliance with all pertinent regulations, the upkeep of all facilities, and the well-being of employees, contractors, and the environment.

Essential duties and responsibilities: (Not all inclusive)

- Assist Area Supervisor in managing daily deployment of personnel that proactively manages preventative maintenance projects and repairs for the assigned area ensuring compliance with WIMS and FIMMS
- Ensure assigned individuals and teams are productively utilized, properly equipped with tools and are in compliance with all safe work practices e.g. LPS, permit requirements and safe work procedures
- Lead assigned individuals and teams ensuring safe and environmentally responsible operations/maintenance as well as compliance with all applicable regulation
- Embrace and champion all safety policies and procedures according to Wolverine's safety program and or industry standards or requirements
- Serve as project planner, including the review of others' plans to ensure safety, technical and quality standards are met including procedure development and review
- Assist Area Supervisor with administrative and other duties assigned
- Mentor and train individual team members
- Conduct and document DOT equipment inspections and meet all DOT requirements, including Operator Qualifications.
- Lead/Assist work team in maintenance, trouble shooting, repair and installation of power and control equipment including but not limited to:
 - Instrumentation
 - Metering Equipment – including flow computers
 - Relay Logic
 - Programmable logic controllers
 - Power systems
 - Motor Control Centers/Switchgear
 - Motors
- Lead/Assist work team in maintenance, trouble shooting, repair and installation of mechanical equipment including but not limited to:
 - Pumps
 - Valves – Plug, Slab, Expanding gate, ball, etc...
 - Piping systems
 - Tubing
- Apply equipment manuals and schematics during the troubleshooting, installation, start-up and design of new systems and equipment.
- Manage schedule for maintaining/replacement of equipment and components.
- Maintain a high level of knowledge relating to new and current technology and equipment.

- Act as project manager on capital and expense projects and serve as occasional project lead inspector for large projects
- Serve as occasional inspector for primary skill projects and contracted field work
- Implement company policies, standards, drawings, diagrams and construction specifications for the installation of new facilities and the repair or upgrade of existing facilities.
- Make recommendations concerning the proper use and types of equipment for new projects.
- Maintain equipment records and furnish documentation per Company policy of work performed.
- Respond to after hour emergency/troubleshooting calls
- Regular attendance

- 5 years' experience in pipeline operations/maintenance or related field with lead worker/foreman experience preferred.
- Electrical and Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) programming and pump/ motor repair, piping system experience is preferred.
- Pipeline or other petroleum industry experience is preferred.
- Working knowledge of governmental regulations that affect pipeline operations is preferred
- Reside within a 30 mile radius of the facility
- Self-starter – takes initiative to identify and solve problems
- Effective communications and presentation skills – both verbal and written
- Valid Driver's license with good driving record.
