Wolverine does not own the product we ship. We are strictly a transport vehicle for our customers, much like UPS or FedEx is for packages. The Federal Government regulates the tariffs Wolverine charges to transport products between origins and destinations.

Summary of duties and responsibilities:

Maintain Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system, in a manner consistent with providing the highest availability and reliability, including hardware, operating systems, networking, databases, user interface (HMI), and other specialized equipment. Assure adherence to standards and regulations governing control room operation, change management, alarm management, and user interface. Maintain off-site emergency backup systems to adequately support operations. Add and expand the SCADA system database and displays as needed to meet expanding infrastructure and enhance system operations.

Essential duties and responsibilities: (Not all inclusive)

- Provide critical SCADA support and maintenance of a 24 x 7 real-time pipeline control system.
- Perform SCADA system implementation, integration, operation, support and maintenance including, but not limited to data analysis, troubleshooting, screen development, database updates.
- Perform SCADA database development of field input/output points, alarming and other database configurations required for OCC operations.
- Perform SCADA display screens creation and maintenance for OCC.
- Work with Automation group and EM's to perform point to point checkouts.
- Effectively and professionally interface with OCC, Automation, IT and other groups inside and outside of the SCADA department in supporting, maintaining and enhancing the SCADA systems.
- Manage work assignments utilizing the Management of Change module in MaCRoM software in accordance with Control Room Management requirements.
- Follow established departmental guidelines, procedures, policies.

- Support directives, decisions and priorities as received from supervisor.
- Operate in a fast-paced environment.
- On-call rotation for 24 x 7 support of OCC.
- Recommend and purchase appropriate equipment, supplies and services.
